Short strides, with a short moment of suspension.

The horse in collection, with engaged hindquarters and light forehand. The neck is raised and arched with the head in a vertical position.

The steps are higher and more energized Speed: 192m/min

Stride length: 2.5m

Stride rate: 77strides/m



Working Trot

Medium stride (stride length between the collected and medium trot).

This trot is the schooled version of the natural gait. It is used when training the horse for the collected trot, thus the name working trot. Speed: 213m/min

Stride length: 2.7m

Stride rate: 79 strides/m



Medium Trot

The horse moves with longer strides and impulsion from the hindquarters, and with the head lower and more in front of the vertical than collected or working trot.

The hindlegs take long steps forward and should track up (the hind hoof hits the ground on the print of the front hoof) Speed: 271m/min

Stride length: 3.3m

Stride rate: 82 strides/m



Extended Trot

The strides have the longest length, with considerable over-tracking covering maximum ground but without rushing the rhythm.

The horse's body is lengthened and the suspension phase is increased due to the great impulsion from the hindquarters. Speed: 299m/min

Stride length: 3.6m

Stride rate: 83 strides/m
