The paper of BEATSON and LIGHT discusses approximation by quasi-interpolants which are sums of scaled translates of a one-parameter family of functions. They do not require reproduction of low-degree polynomials but nevertheless are able to give error bounds and analyze quasi-interpolation based on Gaussians and exponentials. BINEV and JETTER deal with multivariate interpolation using shifts of a single basis function. They treat both gridded data and scattered data. As examples, they consider box splines and certain radial basis functions.
