

Exploring the *practice–pedagogy* middle ground: progress report on a hermeneutic inquiry into education for practice

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What is an appropriate university education for practice in the 21st century, a time when workplaces and the nature of work itself seem to be undergoing continuous change? In this paper we explore the “ideas space” in which the constructs of practice and pedagogy face each other in this climate of change and uncertainty. Our collaboration on the paper arises out of our longer-term work on the first author’s doctoral inquiry into “meaning making capability for 21st century university education”, which seeks to develop new ways of designing and implementing vocational/professional preparation courses.

Preparing students to cope with uncertainty in the workplace requires rich and careful curriculum planning. To illustrate this we refer readers to a curriculum redevelopment in the early 2000s aimed at helping rural management students to be “job-ready” on graduation. The subject *Cropping Systems* was redesigned to provide students with a support structure for their self-managed knowledge and capability development. We profile that design and use it to introduce our new *four fields of interest schema*, which is proposed as a potentially useful curriculum design tool for appropriate education for practice. The paper also illustrates how hermeneutic research affords fresh insights into deep questions of understanding and human purpose, and how such thinking can be seen as part of university-level education.

The three domains of practice, pedagogy and partnerships featured at the 2008 WACE conference demonstrate a holistic viewpoint that challenges educators to draw these three elements together in education for practice curricula. In this paper we focus particularly on the rich space of possibilities where the constructs of pedagogy and practice meet, thereby recognising the value of partnerships between academic and the workplace. We shall, where appropriate, draw ideas from our research into meaning making in university education as we develop our argument here.

Meaning making refers to the process of moving beyond one’s existing frame of understanding into something new. In addition to this notion we are finding that the exploration of this phenomenon is enriched if the ideas of “making meaning” and “finding meaning” (or personal fulfilment, or self-realisation) are held together in our inquiry.

Tuman, 1987 Reading World Literature Sarah Lawall, 2010-01-01 As teachers and readers expand the canon of world literature to include writers whose voices traditionally have been silenced by the dominant culture fundamental questions arise What do we mean by world What constitutes literature Who should decide Reading World Literature is a cumulative study of the concept and evolving practices of world literature Sarah Lawall opens the book with a substantial introduction to the overall topic Twelve original essays by distinguished specialists run the gamut from close readings of specific texts to problems of translation theory and reader response The sequence of essays develops from re examinations of traditional canonical pieces through explorations of less familiar works to discussions of reading itself as a literacy dependent on worldview Reading World Literature will open challenging new vistas for a wide audience in the humanities from traditionalists to avant garde specialists in literary theory cultural studies and area studies **Literacy as Involvement** Deborah Brandt, 2011-02-18 In *Literacy as Involvement* Deborah Brandt examines the cultural and social roots of the acts of reading and writing The book asks for example whether literacy is a natural growth of or a radical shift from orality It questions the contrary views that literacy is either the learning of the conventions of language or is better understood as heightened social ability Finally it raises the possibility that knowing how to read and write is actually understanding how we respond during the acts of reading and writing This examination of literacy as process is also offered as a critique of prevailing theories of literacy advanced by such scholars as Walter J Ong S J David Olson and E D Hirsch They depict literacy as a textual experience that is socially and linguistically detached Brandt critically examines the underlying assumptions from research on writing processes and argues that they call for a major reformation of prevailing conceptions of literacy Specifically she analyzes several expository texts from a process perspective to establish the interaction of reader and writer in even the most seemingly formal and detached writing In her conclusion Brandt brings together the major findings of her study to address pressing literacy issues including the problem of illiteracy in our schools Literacy as Social Exchange Maureen M. Hourigan, 1994-09-27 *Literacy as Social Exchange* examines the intersection of culture and literacy education In particular it explores the roles that class race ethnicity and gender play in students learning to

negotiate the conventions of academic discourse It argues that recent literacy scholarship has tended to isolate class gender and culture as discrete marginalizing factors but such isolation may unintentionally silence voices from non Western non mainstream cultures Writing program administrators and writing teachers who are interested in constructing programs that address the needs of all students in increasingly multicultural classrooms will need to examine how cultural factors influence the way students learn to read write and think critically The author points out that some of the most influential scholars writing about the plight of underprivileged writers teach at some of the most exclusive institutions in the nation These basic writers are not nearly so disadvantaged as many of the student writers most writing teachers encounter every day The author explores enrollment trends in higher education that indicate conclusively that writing classrooms will soon be filled with students from non Western non mainstream cultures Because these students rhetorical and literacy traditions will be unlike both those of their teachers and of the basic writers upon which so much literacy scholarship focuses educators and literacy scholars need to increasingly conceptualize literacy in its larger political social and economic contexts

Postcolonial Literature and the Impact of Literacy Neil ten Kortenaar, 2011-06-02 Examining images of literacy in African and West Indian novels Neil ten Kortenaar looks at how postcolonial authors have thought about the act of writing itself Writing arrived in many parts of Africa as part of colonization in the twentieth century and with it a whole world of book learning and paper pushing of school and bureaucracy newspapers textbooks and letters candles hurricane lamps and electricity pens paper typewriters and printed type and orthography developed for formerly oral languages Writing only penetrated many layers of West Indian society in the same era The range of writers is wide and includes Chinua Achebe Wole Soyinka and V S Naipaul The chapters rely on close reading of canonical novels but discuss general themes and trends in African and Caribbean literature Ten Kortenaar's sensitive and penetrating treatment of these themes makes this an important contribution to the growing field of postcolonial literary studies

Understanding Literacy in Its Historical Contexts Harvey J.
