quarantine station on Canada's West Coast Drawing on the diaries written by Livingstone and the letters of the Canadian missionaries who served as temporary officers with the corps in Europe Dan Black traces the experience of the Chinese Labour Corps and sheds new light on the mistreatment and racism they faced in Canada and in wartime Europe
