army before Richmond in 1862 he finally launched a complex attack that not only failed but left him severely wounded forcing him to turn over command of the Army of Northern Virginia to Robert E Lee Johnston and Confederate President Jefferson Davis had a volatile relationship throughout the war but Johnston was too valuable to leave out of service and at the beginning of 1864 he was given command of the Army of Tennessee When Johnston gradually retreated in the face of Sherman's massive army which outnumbered his 2.1 before Atlanta in 1864 Davis removed Johnston from command of the Army of Tennessee and gave it to John Bell Hood Johnston has never received the plaudits of many of the South's other generals in fact there are only a couple of monuments commemorating his service in the South Yet Johnston was a competent general who fought in some of the most important campaigns of the Civil War and it s often forgotten that it was his surrender to Sherman weeks after Appoint that truly ended the Civil War Johnston did so over Davis's command to keep fighting incurring his wrath once more Great Military Leaders William T.
