(Mostly clear-breasted)
sexes similar

LARK SPARROW *Chondestes grammacus*
4 1/2-5 1/2" (11-14 cm) Note black tail with much white in corner (as in Eastern Tanager, not as in a Vesper Sparrow); also single central breast spot and quail-like head pattern with chestnut ear patch, striped crown, and juvenile like dull adult. Breast finely streaked, back central spot, ear patch duller. **SIMILAR SPECIES:** See Vesper Sparrow (p. 300). **NOTE:** A low song, clear notes and trills with pauses between. **HABITAT:** Prairies, pastures, farms, roadsides. Strays to East Coast in fall and winter.

CLAY-COLORED SPARROW *Spizella pallida*
4 1/2" (11 cm) A small pale sparrow of midcontinent, plain-breasted. Chipping Sparrow-like, but buffier. Note light crown stripe and sharply outlined ear patch, pale lores, gray collar. Chipping and Clay-colored Sparrows both have brown ear patches in fall and winter. Clay-colored has crisp head markings and pale lores, contrasting with its gray collar, white mustache stripe. Rump brown in Clay-colored, gray in Chipping. **NOTE:** Song, insectlike; 3 or 4 low flat notes, buzz, buzz, buzz. **HABITAT:** Scrub, brushy prairies.

GRASSHOPPER SPARROW *Ammodramus saccinervius*
4 1/2-5 1/2" (11-14 cm) A small sparrow of open grasslands with a short sharp tail, flat head, yellow loreal spot, crown with a pale median stripe, back striped with chestnut and black. Differs from other sparrows of meadows in having a relatively unstreaked buffy breast. Flight feeble. **SIMILAR SPECIES:** See Le Coo's Sparrow (p. 300). **NOTE:** Two songs: (1) 2 faint introductory notes and a thin dry buzz, pi-tup-zzz-zzz-zzz-zzz; (2) a thin buzz, tumble of notes. **HABITAT:** Grassland, fields, prairies. Secretive.

BACHMAN'S SPARROW *Ammodramus aestivalis*
4 1/2" (11-14 cm) In dry open pine woods with grass and palmetto scrub of the South, this dry sparrow flushes reluctantly, then drops back into cover. Streaked with reddish brown above, washed with dingy buff across its plain breast, with a gray bill. **SIMILAR SPECIES:** (1) Field Sparrow is smaller, with pink bill. (2) Grasshopper Sparrow lives in meadows, has a light crown stripe and a short tail. (3) Young summer Bachman's suggests Lincoln's Sparrow, which would not be in the South in summer. It has an eye-ring and streaked buffy breast. **NOTE:** Song, variable, usually a clear liquid whistle, followed by a loose trill or warble on a different pitch, e.g., s-s-s-s-s, dip dip dip dip dip (vaguely suggests Heron Throat's song). **HABITAT:** Open pine or oak woods, palmetto scrub. Occasional in northern part of range.

BUTTER'S SPARROW *Ammodramus butleri*
4 1/2-5 1/2" (11-14 cm) Buff breast and plain brown tail. Lateral crown stripe distinct. Unmarked throat and chest. **NOTE:** Song, a continuous whistling or piping running into a dry trill. **SIMILAR SPECIES:** See Grasshopper Sparrow, which is almost identical. **HABITAT:** Grass areas in s. Texas.

CASSIN'S SPARROW *Ammodramus cassinii*
4 1/2" (11-14 cm) A drab sparrow of open arid country. Dingy above, deeper below except for faint streaks on flanks. Throat lacks distinct stripes. Pale or whitish tips on gray outer tail feather. Best characterized by its whistling, which Butter's does not do. **NOTE:** Song, 3 or 4 short high sweet trills, and a lower note; it is increased by 4 or 5 low notes. **HABITAT:** Grassland, brush east to cen. Tex. Casual vagrant farther east.
