and then used his political power to ensure that Madison would run against his good friend Revolutionary War hero James Monroe in a House district teeming with political enemies Overcoming great odds Madison won by a few hundred votes allowing him to attend the First Congress and sponsor the Bill of Rights Packed with colorful details about life in early America this compelling and important narrative is the first serious book about Madison written in many years It will return this under appreciated patriot to his rightful place among the Founding Fathers and shed new light on a key turning point in our nation s history
