DiNardo, 2005 It seemed that whenever Mussolini acted on his own it was bad news for Hitler Indeed the Fuhrer s relations with his Axis partners were fraught with an almost total lack of coordination Compared to the Allies the coalition was hardly an alliance at all Focusing on Germany s military relations with Italy Romania Hungary and Finland Richard DiNardo unearths a wealth of information that reveals how the Axis coalition largely undermined Hitler s objectives from the Eastern Front to the Balkans Mediterranean and North Africa DiNardo argues that the Axis military alliance was doomed from the beginning by a lack of common war aims the absence of a unified command structure and each nation s fundamental mistrust of the others Germany was disinclined to make the kinds of compromises that successful wartime partnerships demanded and because Hitler insisted on separate pacts with each nation Italy and Finland often found themselves conducting counterproductive parallel wars on their own DiNardo s detailed assessments of ground naval and air operations reveal precisely why the Axis allies were so dysfunctional as a collective force sometimes for seemingly mundane but vital reasons a shortage of interpreters for example His analysis covers coalition warfare at every level demonstrating that some military services were better at working with their allies than others while also pointing to rare successes such as Rommel s effective coordination with Italian forces in North Africa In the end while some individual Axis units fought with distinction if not on a par with the vaunted Wehrmacht and helped Germany achieve some of its military aims the coalition s overall military performance was riddled with disappointments Breaking new ground DiNardo s work enlarges our understanding of Germany s defeat while at

the same time offering a timely reminder of the challenges presented by coalition warfare **Deathly Deception** Denis Smyth,2010-06-16 Operation Mincemeat retells the story of the classic World War Two intelligence plan to pass misleading strategic information to Hitler and his Generals that was immortalized in the 1956 Hollywood film The Man Who Never Was Drawing on a wealth of recently available documentation Denis Smyth shows how British deceptioneers solved a multitude of medical technical and logistical problems to implement their deceptive design The aim of their covert plan was to persuade the German High Command that the Allies were going to attack Greece rather than Sicily in the summer of 1943 To achieve this they equipped a dead body with a new military identity as a Royal Marine Major a new private personality as the fianc of an attractive young woman named Pam and a government briefcase containing deceptive documents They then planted the corpse in south western Spanish coastal waters via a stealthy submarine operation and carefully monitored through their codebreakers and spies how the Nazi intelligence services and their warlords proceeded to swallow Mincemeat whole The result was a stunning success The German mis deployment of their forces to meet the notional Anglo American threat to Greece materially contributed to the Allied victory in Sicily which in its turn drove Mussolini from power in Italy and inflicted irreparable damage on the German war effort **The Sicily Campaign** William F. Blitzkrieg to Desert Storm Robert Michael Citino,2004 When Germany launched its blitzkrieg invasion of France in 1940 it forever changed the way the world waged war Although the Wehrmacht ultimately succumbed to superior Allied firepower in a two front war its stunning operational achievement left a lasting impression on military commanders throughout the world even if their own operations were rarely executed as effectively Robert Citino analyzes military campaigns from the second half of the twentieth century to further demonstrate the difficulty of achieving decisive results at the operational level Offering detailed operational analyses of actual campaigns Citino describes how UN forces in Korea enjoyed technological and air superiority but found the enemy unbeatable provides analyses of Israeli operational victories in successive wars until the Arab states finally grasped the realities of operational level warfare in 1973 and tells how the Vietnam debacle continued to shape U S doctrine in surprising ways Looking beyond major power conflicts he also reveals the lessons of India s blitzkrieg like drive into Pakistan in 1971 and of the senseless bloodletting of the Iran Iraq War Citino especially considers the evolution of U S doctrine and assesses the success of Desert Storm in dismantling an entrenched defending force with virtually no friendly casualties He also provides one of the first scholarly analyses of Operation Iraqi Freedom showing that its plan was curiously divorced from the realities of military history grounded instead on nebulous theories about expected enemy behavior Throughout Citino points to the importance of mobility especially mobilized armor in modern operational warfare and assesses the respective roles of firepower training doctrine and command and control

mechanisms Brimming with new insights Citino's study shows why technical superiority is no guarantee of victory and why a thorough grounding in the history of past campaigns is essential to anyone who wishes to understand modern warfare Blitzkrieg to Desert Storm provides that grounding as it addresses the future of operational level warfare in the post 9 11 era

Bendeck, 2021-03-04 Among the operations known as Plan Bodyguard the deception devised to cover the Allies Normandy landing was the little known but critical Plan Zeppelin the largest and most complex of the Bodyguard plans Zeppelin in conjunction with the Mediterranean Strategy succeeded in pinning down

Jack Toffey's War John J. Toffey, 2008 I see this book as the story my father never got to tell John Toffey writes And what a remarkable story it is that Lt Col Jack Toffey never got to tell In this moving account of a young man's journey to know a father who went to war in 1942 and never came back John Toffey weaves memory history and his father's vivid letters home into a fascinating tale of a family a war and the threads that connect them John Toffey was nine when his father's National Guard outfit was mobilized For two years Toffey his mother and his sister moved from post to post before his dad shipped out to North Africa fighting the Vichy French in Morocco then the Germans in Tunisia where he was wounded In July 1943 he went back to war leading an infantry battalion in the invasions of Sicily and southern Italy In January 1944 he landed his battalion at Anzio and was wounded again After a long bitter stalemate Toffey's regiment led Mark Clark's push on Rome On June 3 1944 Jack Toffey was killed in the hill town of Palestrina one day before the Allies marched into Rome In a brutal campaign Jack Toffey had commanded a combat battalion longer than any other officer in the Mediterranean theater Only in 1996 when his father's letters were discovered did John Toffey begin to piece together what happened to his father And he tells this contested story of Allied success and failure with drama steely reserve and balance adding an invaluable perspective to the portrait of Jack Toffey created by Rick Atkinson in his bestselling *Day of Battle* This book is also a lovingly crafted portrait of home front Ohio and how a young boy his sister and his mother waited out their war scanning newspapers and magazines for news of Dad and devouring letters full of easy humor and expressions of love for and pride in his family and dreams of a good life after the war

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
