The Black Queer Work of Ratchet Nikki Lane, 2019-11-27 This book enters as a corrective to the tendency to trivialize and mis appropriate African American language practices The word ratchet has entered into a wider whiter American discourse the same way that many words in African American English have through hip hop and social media Generally ratchet refers to behaviors and cultural expressions of Black people that sit outside of normative middle class respectable codes of conduct Ratchet can function both as a tool for critiquing bad Black behavior and as a tool for resisting the notion that there are such things as good and bad behavior in the first place This book takes seriously the way ratchet operates in the everyday lives of middle class and upwardly mobile Black Queer women in Washington DC who because of their sexuality are situated outside of the norms of Black respectability.
