politicized in contemporary society with the example of Clarence Thomas who condemned the Senate's investigation into allegations of sexual harassment during his Supreme Court confirmation hearings as a high tech lynching Even today as revealed by the 1998 dragging death of James Byrd in Jasper Texas and the national soul searching it precipitated lynchingcontinues to pervade America's collective memory Markovitz concludes with an analysis of debates about a recent exhibition of photographs of lynchings suggesting again how lynching as metaphor remains always in the background of our national discussions of race and racial relations Jonathan Markovitz is a lecturer in sociology at the University of California San Diego
