

BIRDS OF BRITISH SOMALILAND

A QUARTER of a century has passed since the publication of the volumes of Mr. Geoffrey Archer and Eva M. Goodman's *The Birds of British Somaliland and the Gulf of Aden*. In the interval much has been discovered about the birds of north-eastern Africa, and the last two volumes, now published by Oliver and Boyd, give the reader, to his advantage, the discoveries. Like other recent bird books from the same stable, this work is on a grand scale. Where many authors would have confined themselves to bare facts in describing the life histories of breeding habits and eggs of the 450 species and sub-species concerned, Mr. Geoffrey Archer, to whom fell the task of relating their habits, is discursive and anecdotal, describing his experiences at length where they are relevant and quoting where necessary those of others. The result is a work that is as readable as it is authoritative.

Volumes 3 and 4 deal largely with passerine birds, from cockcoos to the 21 species and sub-species of larks, and from wagtails to hawks. The account of them is preceded by an introduction that takes one on a journey through Somaliland, with descriptions of some of the birds typical of the different terraces, and discusses the routes taken by the many birds passing through an area that, since it lies at the cross-roads between Asia and Africa, is of particular interest to students of bird migration. As in the first two volumes, most of the illustrations, which are in colour, are by the hand of Mr. Archibald Thorburn. This is, in fact, the only work on foreign birds that Thorburn illustrated, and the plates are worthy of him at his best. J. K. A.

FOR MEMBERS OF A SYNDICATE SHOOT

IF everyone who is a member of a syndicate shoot read F. G. Standfield's *Syndicate Shooting* (Herbert Jenkins, 18s.), the unfortunate people who have undertaken the management of such shoots would have much easier and pleasanter lives. This admirable book sets out with the greatest clarity every detail of management from legal formalities to vermin control. I believe it would be well worth the cost & manager to present every member of his syndicate with a copy; he might then gain some slight degree of sympathy in his many difficulties.

If there is a fault in this book it is that dogs are not given enough prominence in their handling generally, both in working and picking up or in the very difficult and touchy question of members' dogs. Every member should, I think, undertake in his agreement, never to bring out a dog that is not fully trained, and the manager or the manager and he should also undertake to put his dog on the leash immediately at the request of the manager. A dog should not be regarded as fully trained unless he works entirely to the whistle. A BULB BOOK TO FILL THE GAP

COLLINS GUIDE TO BULBS, by Patrick M. Syngue (Collins, 30s.) fills a real gap in gardening literature, for we have had nothing comparable to this since Mr. Syngue's *The Bulb Book*, long

out of print. It gives an encyclopaedic treatment of plants, both hardy and tender, with bulbs, tubers, corms and rhizomes, and there are very few gaps, though the author has inexplicably left out most of the gentiana tribe, and there are curious omissions among the species of hardy bulbs, which are, I imagine, his favourites.

But this is merely carping criticism of a monumental book that includes some of Paul Fene's admirable colour plates—there are 34

unaccomplished amateur rider. Of *Flowers and Fences* (Michael Joseph, 25s. 1.) is no exception. No matter that it is a case of "the mixture as before"—in other words reproductions of notes that have appeared in *The Observer*—for many, like me, will take pleasure in being reminded of stirring events in the equine world, and will also derive useful information about such diverse matters as riding tactics, racing abroad, "bite and mouth," and betting. All these subjects, and others, are dealt with

for a racing friend, and had I not been too much obliged to the author, I should have bought it for myself. D.W.

ENGLISH POTTERY AND GLASS

WHEN William Harrison wrote over a century ago of the "richness of earth of sundry colours" on the rich Englishman's table, of the fine glass that was preferred to gold or silver, and of the glass tableware sought by "the wealthy commonalty" and even by the poor who, since they could not afford Venetian glass, contented themselves with such as are made at home of fern and burned stone," he was describing not an innovation but a stage in the development of English taste in pottery and glass that has continued since those days. In *English Pottery, Porcelain and Glass* (The Connoisseur, 25s.) L. G. G. Ramsey takes up the story at the beginning of Tudor times and follows it to the end of the early Victorian era.

Part I, on pottery and porcelain, ranges from early lead-glazed and tin-glazed wares to the brilliance of the late-Georgian pottery, and explains how the manufacture of porcelain, because it had no roots in the national tradition, was from the start an attempt to attract patronage for the rich and fashionable. Part II, on glass, covers the broad range of English glass from Henry VIII's "Glasses House" at Westminster to the intricacies of Victorian technical skill. The book is detailed enough to be a useful reference work for the collector, but the writing assumes no special knowledge in the reader and will therefore be comprehensible to the novice. It is admirably illustrated with drawings in the text and with a separate section of 33 pages of photographic plates. The illustrations of makers' marks could, however, have been more usefully arranged for the reader seeking to identify a particular mark. G.G.W.

ESSENTIALS FOR THE DINGHY SAILOR

THE remarkable increase in yachts, yacht clubs, and yacht owners in recent years has led to an understandable increase in the number of books on the subject. The *Syllabus of Sailing* (Macmillan, 21s.) is a new American importation, cannot be said to add a great deal to our knowledge of handling small class boats under racing conditions.

At the same time I would consider it an essential book for every dinghy sailor when he starts at some time in the near future—to come up against American competitors. One thing this book does create is that atmosphere of "professional amateurism" which is too little understood in this country—if we want to win in the Olympics, that is to say. Snipes and Star boats come in for a lot of consideration, but the information given by such American aces as "Bud" Mosbacher is valid for any kind of yacht racing.

The chapters are written by experts ranging from Mosbacher on Racing Starts, to Catamans on Bill Robinson. As Robinson says in his introduction, "This is not a book for the rank novice." It definitely assumes a certain knowledge on the part of its readers. Published originally as a series of articles in *Yachting Magazine*, this is a valuable book for helmsman or crew who take their racing seriously. And, after all, there is little point in racing unless you race to win. E.B.
