Bismarck Arthur Williams, The battleship Bismarck represented the pinnacle of German naval engineering and the embodiment of Nazi Germany's ambitions to challenge British supremacy on the high seas during World War II Launched in 1939 as the lead ship of her class Bismarck was designed to be the most powerful and technologically advanced warship in the world incorporating lessons learned from previous naval conflicts while pushing the boundaries of what was
