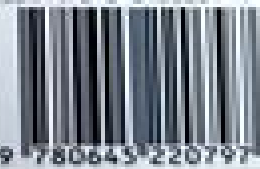

McBrayer, 2014 Given that we meet evils in every quarter of the world could it be governed by an all good and all powerful deity Whilst some philosophers argue that the problem of evil is strong evidence for atheism others claim that all of the evils in our world can be explained as requirements for deeper goods On the other hand skeptical theists believe in God but struggle with the task of explaining the role of evils in our world Skeptical theism tackles the problem of evil by proposing a limited skepticism about the purposes of God and our abilities to determine whether any given instance is truly an example of gratuitous evil This collection of 22 original essays presents cutting edge work on skeptical theistic responses to the problem of evil and the persistent objections that such responses invite Divided into four sections the volume discusses the epistemology of sceptical theism conditions of reasonable epistemic access the implications for theism and the implications for morality

**After Certainty** Robert Pasnau, 2017 No part of philosophy is as disconnected from its history as is epistemology After Certainty offers a reconstruction of that history understood as a series of changing expectations about the cognitive ideal that beings such as us might hope to achieve in a world such as this The story begins with Aristotle and then looks at how his epistemic program was developed through later antiquity and into the Middle Ages before being dramatically reformulated in the seventeenth century In watching these debates unfold over the centuries one sees why epistemology has traditionally been embedded within a much larger sphere of concerns about human nature and the reality of the world we live in It ultimately becomes clear why epistemology today has become a much narrower and specialized field concerned with the conditions under which it is true to say that someone knows something Based on a series of lectures given at Oxford University Robert Pasnau's book ranges widely over the history of philosophy and examines in some detail the rise of science as an autonomous discipline Ultimately Pasnau argues that we may have no good reasons to suppose ourselves capable of achieving even the most minimal standards for knowledge and the final chapter concludes with a discussion of faith and hope

*Atonement and Violence* Hans Boersma, T. Scott Daniels, 2006-11-01 Recent years have witnessed a series of books articles and lectures raising serious questions about the Christian doctrine of the Atonement While coming from a variety of sources the questions usually center around the central issue of atonement and violence Doesn't the Atonement promote the idea of violence on the part of God If so isn't such violence incompatible with a God of love Doesn't this doctrine send the wrong signal excusing and perhaps even promoting such things as child abuse Is it time to
